THE RED RIVER PARISH POLICE JURY met on Wednesday, June 2, 2021, at 10:00 am., in the Police Jury Assembly Room, located in the Red River Parish Courthouse, Coushatta, La in its Regular meeting with Vice-President Ben Taylor presiding. Roll Call and attendance was recorded as follows:

Mr. Jeremy Neal of the Red River Parish Fire District reported that was nothing new to report concerning the Red River Parish fire department for this month and a representative will come quarterly.

Mr. Jeremy Tingler a representative from Gen 6 Sant Plant on 509 came to ask the jury were there any problems and get some suggestions concerning the Abbington Loop Road.

Roads

Nothing new reported for road. CVU Mr. Harold Woodard gave his monthly report on road citations and Road permits.

New Business

Mr. Brown made the motion seconded by Mr. Hillman to approve minutes as written for May, 2021. Motion Carried.

With Mr. Hillman making the motion followed with a second by Mr. Brown The Coushatta Citizen was appointed as the parish official journal for the period beginning July 1, 2021, ending June 30, 2022. Motion Carried.

On the motion of Mr. Davis seconded by Mr. Brown the Red River Police will require people or groups using the Springville Park having water slides etc. or utilizing the kitchen and pavilion to have liability insurance and the required amount of coverage was set at \$300,000.00. Motion carried. The pavilion and kitchen at the park are closed until further notice.

Finances:

Mr. Davis made the motion followed with a second by Mr. Brown to approve to pay bill for the month of May 2021. Motion Carried.

Budget was reviewed but nothing voted on.

Old Business:

On the motion of Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Brown it was agreed to give the president authority to appoint someone to the Northwest La Human Services district. Motion Carried.

Ambulance District:

With Mr. Hillman making the motion followed with a second by Mr. Brown it was approved to pay bills the ambulance district bills for the month of May 2021. Motion Carried.
